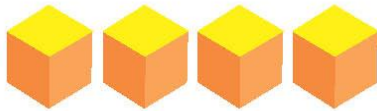
It's the LAW

The State passed two laws that makes it mandatory for businesses, institutions and multi-family complexes to separate recyclables and organics/compostables from their trash. This includes yard waste, food waste and food-soiled paper.

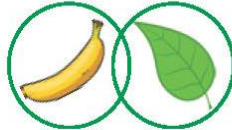
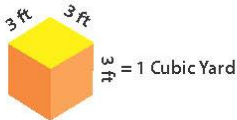
AB 341

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING LAW

AB 341 requires multi-family complexes and businesses that generate 4 cubic yards or more of trash per week to arrange for recycling services.

8 Cubic Yards starts April 2016



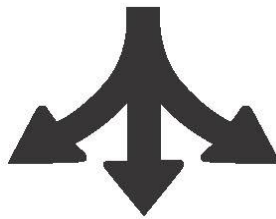
4 Cubic Yards starts January 2017

AB 1826

MANDATORY ORGANICS RECYCLING LAW

AB 1826 requires businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of organic waste to arrange for organic waste recycling services. Beginning January 2019, this requirement extends to businesses that generate 4 cubic yards of trash per week.

Organics include food scraps, yard trimmings, and food soiled paper. Multi-family complexes are only required to recycle yard waste.
